

**Order No. 47/2025
of the Rector of the Poznań University of Life Sciences
of May 28, 2025**

on the basic elements of the organization of the 2025/2026 academic year applicable to full-time and part-time studies

§ 1

Based on Article 23, paragraphs 1 and 2, point 2 of the Act of July 20, 2018, the Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended) and § 25, point 3 of the Statute of the Poznań University of Life Sciences, in conjunction with § 24 of the UPP Study Regulations, the following is hereby ordered:

1. The basic organizational elements of the 2025/2026 academic year are established as follows:

1) in the winter semester:

Classes	from October 2, 2025 to February 2, 2026
Christmas break	from December 24, 2025 to January 6, 2026
winter examination session	from February 3, 2026 to February 13, 2026
mid-semester break	from February 14, 2026 to February 20, 2026
winter re-sit session	from February 21, 2026 to February 26, 2026

2) in the summer semester:

Classes	from February 27, 2026 to June 21, 2026
Christmas break	from April 3, 2026 to April 7, 2026
Summer examination session	from June 22, 2026 to July 5, 2026
Summer re-examination session	from September 1, 2026 to September 13, 2026

2. Additional days off from classes are designated:

October 31 (Friday) – for full-time and part-time studies
November 2 (Sunday) – for part-time studies
November 10 (Monday) – for full-time studies
May 2, 2026 (Saturday) – for part-time studies
May 24, 2026 (Sunday) – for part-time studies
June 5-7, 2026 (Friday-Sunday) – for full-time and part-time studies.

3. A different organization of classes is established on the following dates:

October 1 (Wednesday) – organizational meetings for first-year undergraduate and veterinary students

January 8 (Thursday) – classes will be held according to the schedule for Tuesdays

June 3 (Wednesday) – classes will be held according to the schedule for Fridays.

§2

1. Classes for second-cycle studies beginning in the summer semester begin on March 6, 2026.

2. Classes for engineering studies in semester 7 (the final semester) will continue until December 23, 2025.

3. For bachelor's degree programs, the Vice-Rector for Studies, at the request of the Vice-Dean for Studies, may shorten the duration of classes in semester 6 (the final semester) until May 29, 2026.
4. The Vice-Rector for Studies, at the justified request of the Vice-Dean for Studies, may shorten the duration of classes in the final semester of second-cycle studies.
5. During the shortened period of classes referred to in paragraphs 1-4, teaching hours must be completed in accordance with the study plan.
